2. When this matter was heard fully, this court realised that the arguments of both sides are concerning the interpretation of Rule 16 and prior rules of the Rules, copy of which is annexed to the petition. The argument is that though the petitioner is from Marathwada region, he is entitled to a seat which is vacant (NT-2) in colleges which fall in rest of the Maharashtra region and Vidarbha. The admission cannot be then restricted to the students from Vidarbha or rest of Maharashtra alone. That is because institutional round follows all prior/ CAP rounds. That is to fill the vacant seats. If the vacant NT-2 category seat has to be filled in and that is available in a college in rest of Maharashtra and Vidarbha, that should be filled in strictly on merits or at least the inter-se merit of NT-2 category students. If this is how the matter is viewed or alternatively that against such a vacant seat, a student from Marathwada region can compete, even if the college is situate at Solapur or at Nagpur, then, other students may be affected by the ultimate order in this petition.

3. We propose to dispose of this petition finally. In these circumstances, we direct the Commissioner, CET Cell to display on his website a notice about the pendency of this writ petition and the orders that have been made in the same uptill now. The notice should also direct the students concerned/ affected, if any, and



their colleges in all the three regions that the petition is placed on 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 before this court and that it may be disposed of finally on that date.

4. Stand over to 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2019.
